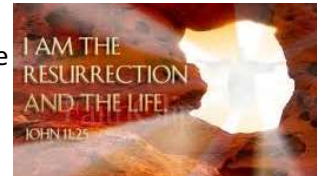

St. Paul's Church will host an ecumenical study event on October 20th at 7.30pm in St Paul's Church, Arran Quay on **Finding Faith in Ireland**. This study, commissioned by Christ in Youth and carried out by Barna Group is one of the most detailed research projects to examine Irish teenagers and young adults, with a specific emphasis on their faith, worries and perceptions of Christianity. Anchored in unique qualitative and quantitative studies, *Finding Faith in Ireland* reveals new data about the beliefs, concerns and ambitions of Irish youth. There is fascinating results in regard to how young Irish people see and relate to the Church; along with revelations from in-depth interviews and surveys which unearth the importance of how spiritual mentors and Christian events play a significant role in the development of faith in Irish young people and young adults. 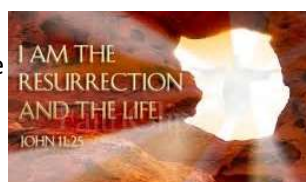
Were You Married in 1992, 1977, 1967, 1957 or 1947?
